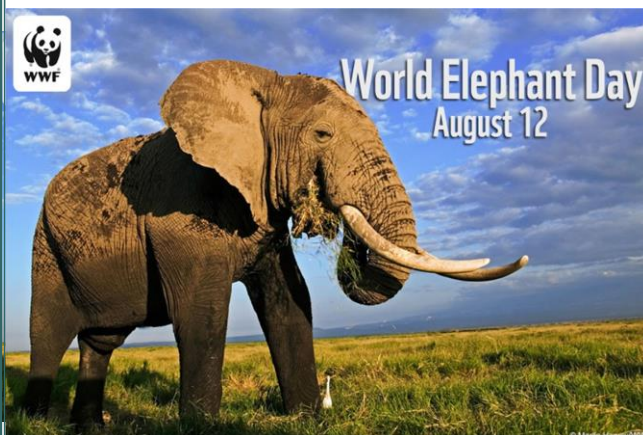

- As per general convention of poster preparation, it is recommended to prepare the poster with heads like Title, Author's detail and content. The size shall be 135 cm (width) x 110 cm (length). The poster must be converted to PDF for submission.
- Participants shall fill up the **Google form** for registration and have to attach the poster there. If they face any error in attaching the poster file there, then they can send it to [zoogushkara@gmail.com](mailto:zoogushkara@gmail.com) with subject of the mail "**e-poster competition**" on or before 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2020 23:59:59 IST.
- The students who are unable to use any laptop or mobile, they can use plain paper for preparation of poster and after it must be converted into the scanned PDF with better resolution for submission.
- The best two posters will be selected and awarded with prizes on that day.
- The decision of the jury will be final.
- All e-posters will be launched in a book format on that day.
- All participants will receive e-certificate of participation.
