GENERAL RULES OF COMPETITIONS

1. Name of the participating candidates (Competition-Wise) must reach the organizing college by **12.11.2016, Saturday, either through E-mail or Hard Copy (by Post / Courier)**. The participants whose names will figure in the sent E-mails/Papers will be allowed to participate in the competition. It is expected that students will be led by one of the Teachers of the respective participating College.
2. Candidates are to bring their **Original College Identity Card** signed by the Principal/TIC/OIC and a **photocopy of University Registration Certificate** duly signed by the same. No student will be allowed to participate in the competition without the above mentioned documents. However, in case of the students who have not yet received the **University Registration Certificate** might bring their **Original Fees Book of the College** duly signed by the Principal/TIC/OIC.
3. In Essay Competition, Essays can be written in any one of the **Seven Languages viz.,** Bengali, English, Hindi, Sanskrit, Nepali, Urdu and Santhali. Except quotations, multilingual presentations are sternly forbidden.
4. **One Quiz Team** consisting of **two students** from a particular College can take part in the **Quiz Competition**.
5. **Only the Students of Undergraduate Level** are entitled to participate in the competitions.
6. On the basis of merit, **First, Second and Third** rank holders in each competition will receive their Prizes and Certificates on **23rd November, 2016**.
7. Only the candidates holding **First and Second Positions in Every Competition** will be allowed to participate in the **State Level Competition**.
8. A candidate can participate in **Maximum Two Events**.
9. Candidates have to bring their own blue-ink ball-point pen(s).
10. There is **no any sort of entry fees / charges** for participating in the competitions.

- ii. Judges' decision in preparing the merit panel / result of the competitions will be considered as FINAL.

COMPETITION SPECIFIC RULES

A. Rules for Essay Writing Competition:

- i. Essay writing competition will be held on the topics related to Netaji's Great Escape, it's effects / consequences in Indian struggle for freedom, Netaji's life and activities etc. Exact Title will be informed / communicated well in advance of the competition.
- ii. Word limit is fixed to 1500.
- iii. Only the blue-ink ball-point pen(s) can be used for writing the essays.
- iv. Only one side of the pages could be used. Writing in both sides of a page is strictly prohibited.
- v. Papers will be supplied by the Organizing College Authority.
- vi. Candidates may use their own Writing Clip Board, if necessary.
- vii. In the first page of the paper Name of the Candidate, Name of his/her College, District, College Roll No. and University Registration No. must be written clearly. However, in case of the students who have not yet received **University Registration Certificate might bring their Original Fees Book of the College** duly signed by the Principal/TIC/OIC.
- viii. Total Forty (40) minutes time will be allowed for writing the essay.

B. Rules for Debate Competition:

- i. Debate competition will be held on the topics related to Netaji's Great Escape and Indian struggle for freedom, contribution of Netaji to make India free from imperialists etc. Exact Title will be informed / communicated well in advance of the competition.
- ii. Total five minutes will be allowed to one candidate. Sequence of competition will be one for-the-motion followed by one against-the-motion alternatively.
- iii. The first competitor will get another one chance of extra five minutes at the end of the deliberation of all candidates.
- iv. Two candidates will be selected for participating in the STATE LEVEL COMPETITION in the way of (a) Topper of for-the-motion and (b) Topper of against-the-motion.
- v. There should have a balance in number of participants from a particular college as far as for-and against-the-motion is considered.

C. Rules for Poster Drawing Competition:

- i. Poster drawing competition will be held on the themes related to Netaji's Great Escape, it's effects / consequences in Indian struggle for freedom, Netaji's life and activities etc. Exact theme will be informed / communicated well in advance of the competition.
- ii. Only the color drawings will be considered for competition.

iii. Organizing college will provide only the Papers for drawing whereas all other drawing materials have to be brought by the competitors.

iv. Total Forty (40) minutes time will be allowed for the competition.

D. Rules for Declamation Competition:

i. Topics for the declamation competition will be selected by the organizers and those will be distributed to each competitor five minutes before his/her own term. The topics selected by lottery method will be based on Netaji's Great Escape, it's effects / consequences in Indian struggle for freedom, Netaji's life, philosophy and activities etc.

ii. Four (4) minutes will be allowed for each candidate's deliberation.

iii. Deliberation in only one language is allowed except the quotations whereas multilingual presentations are strictly prohibited.

iv. During deliberation use of any sort of gadget / paper / tools etc are stringently forbidden.

E. Rules for Quiz Competition:

i. Quiz competition will be held college wise i.e., one college will send a two membered team for participating in this competition.

ii. Competition will be held in five rounds consisting of oral questions, queries using visual and audio medium etc.

iii. Question will be selected from Netaji's Great Escape, it's effects / consequences in Indian struggle for freedom, Netaji's life, philosophy and activities, other freedom fighters, foreign contributions for our independence etc.
