The overall observations of the Academic & Administrative Audit Committee based on inputs collected from all departments are –

- Total number of Students admitted in the 1st Semester during 2018-19:UG-1442, PG-12; 2019-20: UG-1442, PG-17; 2020-21: UG- 1494, PG-22; 2021-22: UG-2096, PG-32; 2022-23: UG- 1605, PG-24
- Honours course in Nutrition, General course in Music and Post-graduate in Bengali have been running successfully from the session 2017-18 along with other twenty courses.
- One Certificate course in Yoga under the affiliation of the University of Burdwan has been made available to the students of the college from the session 2017-18.
- Pass percentage during the above mentioned period were nearly 90% in few subjects of Honours. Over all almost 85% pass percentage was noted amid pandemic conditions.
- Very significant progressions in few subjects from UG to PG were recorded.
- The performances of students in competitive examinations were also noteworthy.

- The performances of Career Counselling and Placement Cell of the college were significant. Many initiatives of the cell were proved beneficial for a large group of students.
- Existence and contributions of different functional subcommittees like ICC. Anti-Ragging, Anti Sexual Harassment, Student welfare committee were noteworthy.
- The very active IQAC cell and its contributions are appreciable.
- The college has an Alumni association viz., PURBITA which contributes in many activities through active participation.
- Regular interaction with Parents and Guardians was noted through PTM (IQAC initiative).
- The college has been extending its social and humanitarian duties through various programmes. The college has organised blood donation camps, COVID vaccination programmes for students, different awareness programmes and rallies and so on.
- Environmental responsibilities of the institution were well documented and also audited report was available under Green Audit category.
- Up to date financial audit including Internal Audit has been done through Gowt. appointed auditors.
- Green campus initiatives mainly by NCC, NSS units and Eco-club of the college were also noted.
- The website of the college was found to be up to date and interactive as well as informative.
- Participation in NIRF, AISHE, RUSA were found up to date.
- AQAR reports were found updated till 2022-2023 A.Y.
- Transparent Admission process through completely online mechanism and Examination process was noted.
- Many noteworthy Best Practices were observed.
- The Publication in Journals and Seminar etc were found noteworthy.
- The college also has an active Research and Development Cell to encourage research activities.

Recommendations of the Audit Team:

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- ✓ Organisations of more Seminar/Workshops on different social issues as well as skill enhancement programmes were recommended.
- ✓ Introduction of few more certificate courses, Diploma courses and Add on courses is required.
- ✓ ICT facility may be increased and more faculties should be encouraged to use them effectively.
- ✓ More projects (Minor/Major) should be taken up.
- ✓ Though the college has its feedback collection & analysis mechanism, it should be strengthened.
- ✓ The vacant NTS posts in college office should be filled up.
- ✓ Choice for subject selection in MDC and VAC under NEP 2020 should be increased
 as far as practicable as per norms set by The University of Burdwan.
